There are three ways to qualify.

First is a Long-Range Observation Appointment

This lets you demonstrate "known ability" and safety awareness as well as range etiquette. An RSO will take you up to the Long-Range and let you confirm zero on your scope and shoot silhouette size targets at 300,400,500,600, and 700 yards. You are allowed seven rounds to make the five impacts. This process should not take more than 30 minutes, and appointments can be made Wed. to Fri 9:30am-4:30pm. Cost is \$50.00 (non-refundable) and is a pass/fail. Email rhett@fossilpointe.net

Second way is to take our Long-Range Training Clinic

The training clinic is designed to give participants the knowledge and fundamentals to precisely shoot targets at distance. This is a "ground-up" class where each shooter will thoroughly go through their gear to ensure proper setup and learn specifically with their equipment. The clinic runs 8am-6pm with a break for lunch. Cost is \$399.00. Check calendar for class schedule.

Here is a list of items needed to participate in the training clinic:

- Comfortable durable clothing—rain/inclement weather gear

Third way is to take a Private Lesson
